## GENERAL SUPPLIES:

Your machine - $1 / 4$ " foot NO flange of seam guide Rotary cutter (sharp blade) and small mat Square ruler (I use Omnigrid 9-1/2 or Creative Grids) Scissors, a few straight pins, baggie for scraps Pigma brush tip pen (I will have some in class $\$ 4$ ) Fabrics pre-cut and bagged by size (I do recommend starching before cutting, but it's a personal choice)

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## CREAM - 1 \& $1 / 2$ yards

(4) 8 " squares (NYB blocks)
(24) 3 " $\times 4$ " rectangles (NYB blocks)

(96) $2 " \times 3$ " rectangles (Spire strip)
(16) 3 " squares cut on diagonal (Star)
(16) 3-1/2" squares cut on diagonal (Star)

## PINK - 1/4 yard

(20) $2-1 / 2 " \times 3-1 / 2$ " rectangles (NYB blocks)


GREEN PRINT \#1 - $\mathbf{1} / 4$ yard
(16) $2 " \times 4-1 / 2 "$ rectangles (Star)

GREEN PRINT \#2 - 1/4 yard
(16) $2 " \times 4-1 / 2 "$ rectangles (Star)


BINDING (Your choice) - $3 / 8$ yard
(4) $2-1 / 2 "$ x WOF strips
