

Rulerwork for Beginners

Fantasy Feathers featuring the Westalee Feather 4pc Template Set

Supply List:

Item demo'd during the class

- The Westalee Rulerfoot Starter Foot Set or a ruler foot appropriate for your machine along with the Westalee 12" arc from the starter set. (Other 1/2" rulerfoot may be used as appropriate for your machine.)
- The Westalee 4 Feather Template Set
- Westalee Stable Tape
- Westalee Spacing Gauge
- Gliders (Freemotion or Rulerwork Gliders)
- Flat Extended Machines surface like a Sew Steady table or similar. (This is important for success in this technique because the ruler needs to rest somewhere flat and be able to move more than just a few inches.)

NOTE 1 : Rulerfoot must match your machine and your templates should match your rulerfoot style. IE., a low shank foot goes on a low shank machine and uses a low shank style ruler or template.

NOTE 2 : Ability to drop your feed dogs or feed dog cover for your machine is highly recommended as is the use of an appropriately sized, flat extension table. No smaller than an 18"x 24" extension table size is recommended for best results. It is much harder to use this method without an extension table. These may take 4-6 weeks to order in some places so please do not wait until that last minute to secure one for your machine.

Standard quilting supplies are also recommended:

- 2 Fat Quarter Quilt Sandwiches (A good quality batting and fabric is recommended for best results)
- 90/14 Topstitch or Quilting needle
- Polyester 40wt or 50wt 3 ply thread in a low contrast to the fabric but not matching as we want people to see what they are doing.
- Appropriate spool cap and/or thread support for the type of thread being used.
- Thread snips
- Quilt safe marking tools
- Rotary ruler for measuring and marking on the quilt sandwich (8"x14" or similar)
