Mariner's Compass Class

SUPPLY LIST:

- 1 Compass kit (which includes the pattern, the compass fabric, and freezer paper foundations enough for one compass design and template precuts. (The class will focus on the completion of one compass design. Fabrics may vary but will have the same basic colorway as the sample quilt.)
- 1-2 old machine needles to use when sewing through the freezer paper to make the foundation patterns.
- A thin strong piecing thread for the top thread and 2 matching bobbins as well as an 80/12 universal piecing needles in recommended for the general sewing requirement.
- Add a Quarter ruler (Essential tool for paper piecing work, 12" size if preferred.)
- Hand Pressing Iron for Paper Foundation Piecing (This simple tool limits electricity requirements in class and limits sharing requirements.)
- Rotary Cutter and personal size cutting mat. There is a lot of trimming in this class and this way we can limit the need for a shared cutting table. The pieces needing to be trimmed are relatively small, but there are quite a few so this will make that task faster to have a small cutting area nearby.
- A water-soluble school glue stick.
- General quilting notions such as straight pins, seam ripper, scissors, sharpie, and any other sewing comfort tools you like for quilt piecing.
- A 1/4" piecing presser foot is a must to attach to your machine. Without a guide may be preferred for this technique but bring both if you have then so you can decide which you like better.
- Light and Dark Fabric Marker
- Good fabric scissors to cut out the background fabric.

NOTE: You must know how to use your machines and be familiar with it. There is no time in this class to teach you how to use your machine. Make sure to bring manual and accessories and have it ready to use.
